This is our eighteenth (non-consecutive due to COVID) year hosting a Civil War living history event in Angelica, NY, and we are always adding additional activities. All impressions of military and civilian reenactors and your scenarios are welcome.</p>	



Advance registration is \$10.00. Deadline for advance registration is **RECEIPT OF REGISTRATION FORM AND PAYMENT by September 1st, 2022**, and anyone registered but not paid by September 1 will pay the \$12.00 late registration fee. We must impose this requirement due to the number of no-shows who we prepare for, and lose money on, due to them not arriving as promised.

Activities include lots of Living History, encampment and three battles including spectacular **downtown street tactical through the historic district** each day. A Beef on Weck buffet supper will again be available Friday evening for all reenactors. Activities including Living History, and multiple battle scenarios. Additional details at registration or on our website as available.

Firewood and other usual amenities provided. Sanitary facilities available throughout the reenactor areas.

2022 ANGELICA CIVIL WAR WEEKEND

Dear Fellow Reenactor,

The Angelica Civil War Weekend began in 2004 as a program for the Allegheny Highlands Council Boy Scout Fall Camporee, and fourteen years ago became a full-fledged reenactment event. Any of the attendees from past years can tell you we host a fun event, and that the Angelica Community is substantially period correct and VERY friendly to reenactors!

After a few years we left the fairgrounds and held the event entirely at locations throughout the circa 1806 Village of Angelica, with camps along Main Street in the historic district. Feedback from all of you AND from the Village residents indicated this was a success. As we have done in the past, the battles will again encompass both street battles and an open field battle. The Boy Scout Council will again be participating this year, but in a more limited capacity due to their own internal restrictions. We have decided not to host a School Day this year, for similar reasons. Many of the local community organizations are anxious to welcome the re-enactors back, and in recreating the 1860's. Reenactors are always encouraged to stage scenarios throughout the period village. As always, we will try to have something new for you to try!

REGISTRATION & AMENITIES: Registration fee is \$10.00 per person for those 12 and older. Sorry for the increase, but all costs have gone up for us. Children under 12 are free. Unfortunately, in order to avoid losing money due to no-shows, we must insist on receipt of the registration form AND payment by the deadline to qualify as pre-registered. There is a FREE welcoming meal on Friday night, free good quality firewood, and sanitary facilities will be provided throughout the area of the camps. Pre-registration is required to obtain the food amenities.

Sadly, City Fiddle is no longer available for the dance, but we will have the Wild Root String Band again, who were our band last year and a fine alternative.

ALSO PLEASE NOTE: The East End Grocery Store is no longer in business, and no gasoline is sold there. A Dollar General is in town, and there is a grocery in Belfast, and closest fuel is at the Quicklee's 5 miles West on I-86

BOUNTIES: We can offer bounties only for the first 3 artillery pieces registered and taking the field on each side. Pre-registration is required, and the postmark date will determine eligibility.

FOOD: Friday 6:00pm until 9:00pm, a free supper will be available for all reenactors (please bring your own plates and utensils). Local organizations and businesses will be offering meal specials and we are hoping the Legion will hold their Pancake Breakfast on Sunday morning.

BOY SCOUT LIVING HISTORY PROGRAM THIS YEAR: In past years, we have hosted a School Education Day on Friday, and a similar program for the Boy Scouts on Saturday morning. We have again elected to skip the Friday School Education Day this year. Hopefully it will return in future years. The Boy Scouts will still be present for Education Stations on Saturday morning however, but with some restrictions on what types of activities can be held, so they will not be holding their own battle this year.

We ask that you PLEASE patronize the local organizations who are providing food this weekend. Without the support of the Legion, the Fire Department and other local not-for-profits we could not host this event!

Notice This event is held in residential areas of the Village and on private property. Please observe all local regulations and be considerate of our hosts. Quiet hours are 11:00PM each night. Please stay quiet after this time. Remember, homeowners are allowing us to use their property, and some reenactors have long drives ahead of them on Sunday.

YOU ARE ASKED TO REMAIN IN PERIOD PERSONA AT ALL TIMES WHILE THE PUBLIC IS PRESENT, INCLUDING ANY EVENING ACTIVITIES. Please, no vulgarities on the field or in camps. The public is near by at all times.

No vehicles, other than emergency or event authorized vehicles are allowed on the Village Streets in the Historic District or in the camps, from 8 AM Saturday until 4 PM on Sunday. If you arrive after 8 AM on Saturday, plan to park at the fairgrounds and take the shuttle or walk your gear in. All vehicles on site must be removed NO LATER than 8 AM Saturday morning to the parking areas on fairgrounds. Village police will be enforcing a “No Parking” ordinance this year with no parking allowed on Village streets for the weekend. ALL parking will be at the fairgrounds. Please do not move your car to downtown until after the close of the event.

No one under 16 allowed on the field unless as a functional musician or runner and then only with field commander permission, and written permission from parent. Persons under 16 are not to be involved in the active fighting. **No children under the age of 12 will be allowed on the battlefield under any circumstances.**

Unit commanders are responsible for their units conduct on the field, and will be held accountable. All soldiers taking the field will do so with a filled canteen.

Please protect your personal property. The event hosts or organizers are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please keep your vehicles locked at all times.

All trash to be bagged and either taken with you, or placed in the dumpster in parking lot North of Park Circle. **DO NOT leave trash bags by the port-a-pottys**
